Bayport VA – Pool with Rivah Base options

Site of 2008 Summer Camp. Bayport provides opportunities for forty-five different merit badges and the unique Nighthawk program for the first year camper. Rivah base include Chase Sailing, Water Sports Program, and Climbing

Goshen VA – Lake only and Technology Center

Merit Badges include: Aquatics: Canoeing, Rowing, Kayaking, Motor Boating, Swimming, Lifesaving, BSA Lifeguard, Sailing (min. 13 years old). Scoutcraft: Orienteering, Camping, Wilderness Survival, Emergency Preparedness, Pioneering, Hiking, and Fishing. Technology Center: Merit badges Scouts cannot earn at any other base camp are offered; such as Engineering, Nuclear Science, Computers, Electronics, and Photography. Come on in and enjoy the air conditioning. Field Sports: Rifle, Archery, Shotgun. Handicraft: Leatherwork, Basketry, Sculpture, and Woodcarving. Ecology: Environmental Science, Mammals, Reptiles & Amphibians, Nature, Insect Study, Astronomy, Bird Study, Forestry, Geology, Weather and Soil and Water Conservation.

Ockanickon PA – Pool

Ockanickon Scout Reservation offers one of the largest merit badge programs in the Northeast Region with over 50 badges offered during every week of camp. We also have the nation's first Boy Scout Science Center which offers such hard to find badges as: Atomic Energy, Chemistry, Electricity, Electronics, & Astronomy (we even have a planetarium). Our High Adventure Programs include: Rock Climbing, C.O.P.E., Sailing (on Lake Nockamixon) and Mountain Biking (on brand new Cannondale bikes). New scouts will find the "Dan Beard Program" uniquely designed to offer them valuable training in the Tenderfoot to First Class requirements with plenty of free time to earn other awards and explore and enjoy the camp.

Sinoquipe PA – Lake Only

Sinoquipe has a beautiful lake offering swimming, canoeing, and recreational kayaking. Camp also provides courses in first aid, emergency preparedness, pioneering, cooking, scoutcraft, handicraft, sports, public speaking, plumbing, archery, rifle & shotgun shooting, ecology and horsemanship (and numerous others!) All areas teach merit badges during the day.

Tuckahoe PA – Pool

Traditional Summer Camp badges with large main lodge. Tuckahoe provides a first-rate "traditional" summer camp program for Boy Scouts, combined with exciting state-of-the-art facilities such as the camp's Project COPE course, a swimming pool and bath house (complete with private individual shower facilities), and spacious air-conditioned dining hall capable of comfortably seating 500 campers at a sitting.
