This is the 21st straight year we have participated in this event. As usual, we will be assisting the Marines in running the Lee Hwy Water Station. We do both set-up prior to, and distribution during, the race. It's a lot of fun, and the Scouts usually enjoy it thoroughly. All participants will receive the coveted MCM T-Shirt. There is no charge for this event, but we will hit local spot for breakfast and/or lunch, so Scouts should have \$5-10 cash in hand. We will assemble at the Parish Center at 6:00 a.m. on Sunday morning. **All Scouts must be dressed in FULL SCOUT UNIFORM**, and should also be dressed in layers appropriate to the weather. A day-pack to put clothes into as the day warms up is an excellent idea. The event is essentially finished by 10:30 a.m. Those Scouts not interested in lunch will be returned home directly; all others after lunch (by 12:00, based on past experience). **We definitely need Adult assistance for this event, and also definitely need Senior Scout participation.** The Georgetown Water Station is the Marathon's most important station, and the Marines will be counting on us!

HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE: Go to http://www.doitsports.com/volunteer2/join-protected-group.tcl?event_id=2061 , This will take you to a login page. Our group is "BSA 111" (we are the first on the scroll-down list this year); the password is: EAGLE (type it in using all caps, then click on the "Join Group" button). This will take you to an information page. Fill in all the data. Three items of note: First, be sure to fill in your T-Shirt size, and Scouts should remember to get one size too large so they can grow into them. Please keep track of what size you requested (as in, write it down someplace). **DO A SEPARATE FORM FOR EACH**

SCOUT AND ADULT! Second, if you are under 18 **WHEN YOU REGISTER**, your parent will need to fill in the information at the very bottom of the page. Note that it doesn't matter if you'll turn 18 between now and the date of the Marathon. Third, you must agree to the waiver at the bottom (Click on "I agree"). When done, click on the "Join Group" button. This will take you to a brief information page. Ignore the listed time frame - we go much earlier to help set up the station.
